Isaiah 53:5

5 But he was pierced **for** our transgressions, he was crushed **for** our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

Isaiah 53:12c

12c ... For he bore the sin of many, and made intercession **for** the transgressors.

Romans 4:25

25 He was delivered over to death **for** our sins and was raised to life **for** our justification.

Romans 5:8
 8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died **for** us.

1 Corinthians 15:3
 3 For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died **for** our sins according to the Scriptures,

1 Peter 3:18
 18 For Christ died **for** sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive by the Spirit,

2 Corinthians 5:21
 21 God made him who had no sin to be sin **for** us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

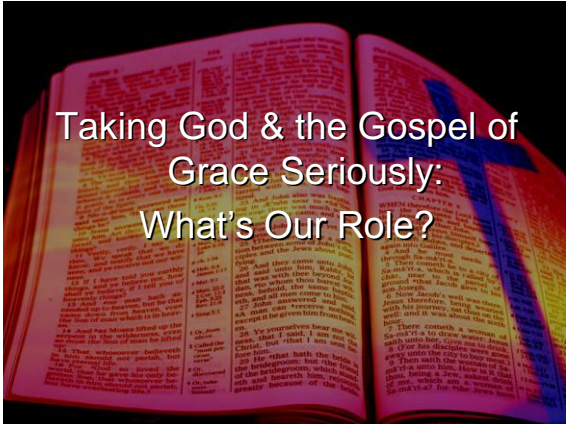
